Things that Accompany Salvation (Heb 6.9) The Fruits, Evidences, & Knowledge of Being Born Again

"Examine yourselves, whether ye be in the faith; prove your own selves. Know ye not your own selves, how that Jesus is in you, except ye be reprobates [unapproved, i.e. rejected]?" 2Co 13:5

A. THE FRUITS OF BEING BORN AGAIN: Examine (test, scrutinize, discipline) yourselves "But let a man examine himself.... For if we would judge ourselves, we should not be judged." (1Co 11.28.31, see Ps 26.2)

- 1. joy Ps 51.12, 9.14, 13.5, 20.5, 21.1, 35.9, Isa 25.9, Jn 15.11, 16.22, 17.13 & hope 1Th 5.8 (cp Eph 2.12), Tit 1.2, 3.7, Col 1.5,23, 1Pe 1.3, Ro 8.24
- 2. spiritual understanding (to perceive the KOG) Jn 3.3 (cp Eph 4.18), 1Jn 5.20
- 3. a craving for the Word of God (for it is opened unto you) Lk 24.32,45, 1Pe 2.2 [Remember, hungering is a sign of being alive Mt 5.6]
- 4. fellowship with God (you know Him, not of/about Him) Jn 17.3, 1Jn 1.1-3 you cry Abba, Father in your prayers [not God] Mk 14.36, Ro 8.15, Gal 4.6
- 5. godly [not worldly] sorrow that works repentance unto life 2Co 7.9-11
- 6. undergo persecution for righteousness sake Gal 4.28-29
- 7. experience freedom from the law Gal 4.28-31

Permissibility to the flesh causes a withering of these fruits

B. THE EVIDENCES OF BEING BORN AGAIN (all in 1Jn): Prove (test & approve) yourselves "But let every man prove his own work, and then shall he have rejoicing in himself alone, and not in another." (Gal 6.4) "... to prove the sincerity of your love." (2Co 8.8)

- 1. you do righteousness [i.e. equity (what is right)] (2.29, 3.10)
- 2. you do not commit [habitually do] sin (3.9, 5.18): endure temptation, Jam 1.12, 1Pe 4.1-3, Gal 5.24, Eph 4.19-24
- 3. you cannot [remain in or freely] sin (3.9)
- 4. you love one another: brotherly love (1Jn 4.7-8, 3.10-11, 1Th 4.9)
- you believe that Jesus is the Christ (5.1,10, 4.15)
 (i.e. you have a clear confession of faith in the Lord Jesus)
- 6. you overcome the world & the god of this world, Satan (5.4-5): Rev 12.10-11, 2.7,11,17,26, 3.5,12,21, 21.17
- 7. you keep yourself from all idolatry (5.18,21, 2.15-17)

This evidence is countered by works that deny him (Tit 1.16)

C. THE KNOWLEDGE OF BEING BORN AGAIN: Know (to know upon some mark, i.e. recognize, to become fully acquainted with, to acknowledge) yourselves

"These things have I written unto you that believe on the name of the Son of God; that ye may know that ye have eternal life, & that ye may believe on the name of the Son of God " (1Jn 5.13) "Which is a manifest token of the righteous judgment of God" (2Th 1:5).

- 1. by your obedience 1Jn 2.3-6 (cp Tit 1.16)
- 2. by the desire to be like Him 1Jn 3.2-3
- 3. by your love for the brethren 1Jn 3.14-19, 4.12
- 4. by your witness & testimony of Him 1Jn 4.13-15
- 5. by the Spirit which He has given you 1Jn 3.24, 4.13, Ro 8.15-16, Gal 4.6-7 the Spirit's inner witness
- 6. thru the righteousness, judgment, lovingkindness, mercies, & faithfulness of the Lord, Hos 2.19-20, & especially, thru the forgiveness of your sins Jer 31.34/Heb 8.10-12, Lk 1.77
- 7. by our fruits Mt 7.16-23

The effects of sin cover the glory he's put within us (2Co 4.6-7)
